

BSc (Hons) in Banking Practice & Management

Whether you are in, or aspiring to, a middle or senior management position, the BSc (Hons) in Banking Practice and Management will provide you with the expert knowledge and skills required to enhance your career prospects. The degree is delivered, assessed and awarded by the ifs School of Finance. The compulsory module of the degree, Strategic Management in Financial Services, will take you through a variety of topics, including strategic management concepts and skills with reference to case studies and empirical evidence. The option modules within the degree encompass a wide range of subjects, allowing you to focus your study to support your own career path. On completion of the programme you will be awarded with the designation: BSc (Hons).

To complete the BSc you need to achieve 120 (UK) credits by completing a combination of compulsory modules and optional electives which in all account to 4 modules of 30 credits each from a selection of 8 modules to choose from. The course of study for every module lasts 24 weeks and the overall study time is equivalent to 300 hours (approximately 12 hours per week), including assessment preparation time. You will be guided through your studies by the learning materials and supported by your online tutor.

Assessment & Duration

All modules are assessed by a combination of 3 hour exam (70%) and 1 assignment (30%). There is a limit of 4 years from your first BSc registration to complete the qualification. You will not be allowed to re-register for the qualification if you do not complete within this time limit.

Entry Requirements

120 credits at EQF Level 5 through completion of the Foundation Degree in Banking Practice and Management (FdSc) or the Diploma in Higher Education in Financial Markets and Management (DipHE)

OR

Honours degree or equivalent in a relevant discipline that demonstrates coverage across the FdSc / DipHE learning outcomes. If awarded more than seven years before the application to join the programme, evidence that the learning and skills have been maintained must be provided.
