As the financial services sector is a highly regulated one, regulatory laws and underlying principles will also be considered.

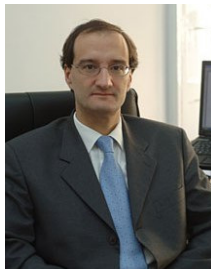
